



## Code of Ethics

This Code of Ethics Policy is for all members of Delta Beta Tau Co-Ed Fraternity (DBT) at San Diego State University. DBT serves to promote and maintain the highest standards of personal conduct among its members. Adherence to these principles by members of DBT is required and such actions serve to assure public confidence in the integrity and behavior of members of the organization. The code of ethics reinforces the values of this organization and the accountability of all members to live out these values.

As a member of DBT, I personally commit myself to these provisions and will be ever mindful of the importance of acting on these ethical principles during my daily practice.

If I fail to conduct myself in the manner of statements listed below, I may be subject to a membership review by the DBT Ethics Council. Failure to comply with statements listed below could also result in being removed from DBT.

I Vow To:

1. Maintain the highest standard of personal conduct.
2. Actively promote and encourage the highest level of ethics within DBT.
3. Maintain loyalty and pursue objectives in ways that are consistent with DBT.
4. Recognize my responsibility to uphold all laws and regulations relating to DBT policies and activities.
5. Strive for excellence in all aspects of management and leadership of DBT.
6. Use only legal and ethical actions in all of my DBT activities.
7. Serve all members of DBT impartially.
8. Maintain the confidentiality of privileged information entrusted or known to me by virtue of my membership.
9. Refuse to discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, or disability.
10. Always communicate in a truthful and accurate manner by assuring that there is integrity in the information shared by myself or others within DBT.
11. Cooperate in reasonable and proper ways with members and work with them in the advancement of DBT.
12. Use every opportunity to improve public understanding of the role of DBT.
